Storage Policies

1. Eligibility for Storage:

- a. Only CLSC members in good standing may apply to store a boat at the club.
- b. The applicant must own the boat being stored.
- c. When a boat is jointly owned, all owners must be members of CLSC.
- d. Members must re-apply for storage space each year with their membership renewal.
- e. The Club Executive at its sole discretion shall allocate available space.

2. Priority of Storage:

- a. The executive shall prioritize the allocation of storage space on the following basis:
 - i. Boats that belong to the CLSC (Lesson boats, Club boats),
 - ii. Active members in good standing.
- b. An active member is defined as someone who frequently sails at the club and participates as a volunteer in support of the club functions.
- c. If the storage fee is not received at the time of membership renewal, the member must remove said boat and personal belongings forthwith. Failure to do so shall result in the Executive arranging for the boat to be removed to an impoundment lot at the owner's expense. 14 days written notice will be given prior to any action being taken.
- d. If a member removes their boat for an extended period (2 months) during the sailing season (May to October), they must notify the Executive so that space may be temporarily re-allocated. They will not lose their storage space privileges within the current payment period.

3. Privileges to Use of Storage

- a. Storage privileges are not transferable.
- b. When a boat changes ownership, the boat must be removed from the compound.
- c. Members must re-apply to change the type of boat stored.

4. Member and Club Responsibilities:

- a. Boats are required to be kept in good, clean condition.
- b. Members are required to maintain the storage space in a neat and tidy manner. Boats that are left unattended or appear derelict may be removed at the discretion of the executive. *See removal process 2.c.*
- c. Boats are stored at owner's risk. CLSC does not accept any responsibility for the security of boats or responsibility for damage or loss due to theft, vandalism, weather or any other causes.
- d. Members are responsible for securing their boats and will be held responsible if their boat damages another boat or club property. Each member stored boat requires a minimum of \$1,000,000.00 liability insurance according to the Clubs Constitution and By-Laws BL. 2.4 b (insurance)

All members who store a boat at the Club compound and/or participate in Club sailing events shall carry general liability insurance of not less than \$1,000,000.00 for loss or damage resulting from the storage or use of the member's boat. Members shall provide the Secretary with proof of insurance upon request. The Club is not liable to any member if a member fails to insure or fails to comply with the Secretary request for proof of insurance.

- e. Failure to adhere to these rules may result in a request by the Executive for removal of the boat and loss of storage privileges. *See removal procedures 2. c.*

5. Non-members boats

- a. Non-member boats and property shall be removed at the Owner's expense. Reasonable attempts will be made to contact the boat owner before this action is taken.

6. Members' road trailers are not allowed to be stored on site.
